

## Selwyn College MCR Open Meeting 8<sup>th</sup> March 2015

### Minutes

Meeting opened: 19:39

13 members in attendance

6 items for the Agenda

#### **1) Funding for MCR Cricket**

- Due to a high level of interest from the MCR to participate in cricket, it may be worthwhile to use some of the MCR budget for the team.
- Proposition to use MCR budget (no more than £100) to purchase new cricket gear.
  - Those present voted in favour of the proposition.

#### **2) SCR invitation to the Annual Dinner**

- In order to build a stronger relationship between the SCR and MCR, the committee proposes to invite members of the SCR, as well as certain individuals of the college staff (such as the porters), to the Annual Dinner.
- Those invited would pay for their own ticket to the event.
- The seating plan for the dinner would integrate SCR and MCR members (similar to the Matriculation Dinner), and would possibly employ the high table in order to provide more space.
- Proposition to invite the SCR and various members of the college staff to the Annual Dinner.
  - Those present voted in favour of the proposition.

#### **3) GU and CSU Elections**

- An update from Vice President Angelo Di Bernardo on the elections showed that there was a good turnout from Selwyn.

#### **4) Electoral Register**

- Those who are able and willing to vote in the upcoming election should make sure to register. This will require a National Insurance number, which can be obtained if individuals do not have one.
- Additionally, currently registered MCR members should offer help to those who would like to register.

#### **5) Rents Liaison Committee Report**

- Rent will be increasing next year by 4%
- College has reported that there is an increase because it is losing money on rent.
- Treasurer Max Conway has asked for a breakdown of college expenditures on rooms/maintenance. He will receive this on Tuesday.

#### **6) Wireless Internet connection in Cripps Court**

- Wireless Internet is very unreliable in Cripps Court and members propose to ask college as an MCR to improve the connection.
- Computing Officer Will Drazin reported that Selwyn is aware of this problem and hopes to fix several wireless problems around the college.
- Propose to make a spreadsheet with the names of individuals experiencing problems and present it to college.
