Minutes

Meeting opened at 16:20

14 members in attendance

4 items for the Agenda

1) Voting in new members as Class C

- Two 4th year engineers have expressed an interest in joining the MCR: Jimi Oluwole and Logan Vasudeva.
 - 13 voted Jimi and Logan into the MCR as class C members, 1 abstained.
- Natalie Greenfield was here for an MPhil last year and was elected as Ents Officer during her time here. She is continuing to help out in committee and would like to join the MCR.
 - 13 voted to have Natalie join the MCR as a class C member, 1 abstained.
- Amy Barstow (the partner of Josh Maher) is currently a Class D member, but would like be voted in as a Class C member.
 - 13 voted to have Amy join the MCR as a class C member, 1 abstained.

- The money previously spent for CUSU membership will be saved and used to fund more MCR events.

- Interested MCR members will need someone from the committee to nominate and second them. They will also need to write a brief proposal explaining why they would like to run.
- Committee positions run from January to December (2016). MPhils are encouraged to run, and their term will finish in June/July.
