

Selwyn College MCR Open Meeting 14th September

Minutes

Meeting opened: 19.35

13 members in attendance

One Item for the Agenda – Printing Charges are changing.

The College is proposing to switch to a university-wide printing service which is pre-paid top-up. This will require topping up your printing account prior to use, whereas current College policy is to charge in the termly bill.

The current charges are as follows:

- For colour: 15p per A4 **side**, 25p per A3 **side**
- For b&w: 4p per A4 **side**, 8p per A3 **side**

The new proposed charges are as follows:

- For colour: 30p per A4 **side**, 60p per A3 **side**
- For b&w: 5p per A4 **sheet**, 10p per A3 **sheet**

Points raised against:

- Colour printing will be more expensive under the new rules
- Some consider it more convenient to pay at the end for use instead of pre-paying
- May waste money in advance – this isn't possible with the current system

Points raised in favour:

- B&W printing will be cheaper for multiple pages
- This affects the JCR more than the MCR, because most graduate students have unlimited printing from their departments
- May be more convenient for others as it helps them keep better track of their printing and spending

Vote on whether we are happy with the proposed changes to the printing system:

- 9 in favour, 4 abstain, 0 against

Any Other Business?

Milk, tea and coffee: is it being replaced? Will Drazin buys UHT milk, and there is plenty of it. More tea needs ordering, and we should buy sugar – preferably Demerara.

Next open meeting: voting in Nikolina Skandali-Kwstopoulou to join the MCR.
